

is for doctor. A doctor is someone who takes care of people who are sick. Doctors are kind and caring, and they are also very curious about the mysteries of the human body.




is for engineer. An engineer is someone who builds machines and structures. For example, civil engineers build bridges and railways, while mechanical engineers build elevators and engines.

is for military officer. A military officer serves India by fighting in the army. Military officers are courageous and patriotic, and they work well with others.




is for news reporter. News reporters alert the public of important events, such as sports games, government elections, and disasters. News reporters are good writers who are curious to understand the truth.

is for veterinarian. A veterinarian is someone who takes care of sick animals and helps them become healthy again.




is for writer. A writer is someone who uses words to tell stories. Some writers create books, while others make poems, and others create songs.
